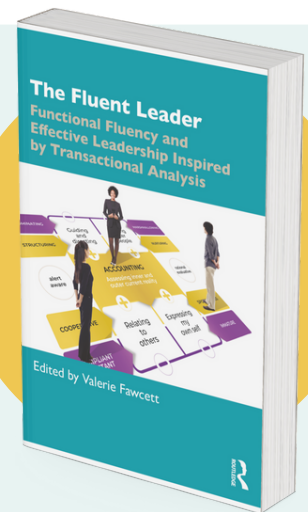


Book Review; The Fluent Leader
