# Achieving behavioural change effectively with Functional Fluency and TIFF©

Experienced professionals are often looking for the best for their clients, for the path with the most value, because that is, after all, their mission. Coaches, trainers, supervisors and other helping professionals know that it is nice to work with practical and effective tools to stimulate their client's growth. The TIFF<sup>®</sup> Providers Licensing training offers this possibility.

Functional Fluency gives a clear insight into the effectiveness of behaviour. Developed by Susannah Temple, Functional Fluency is a smart and simple model for understanding how people behave. It provides a practical framework to help them build effective relationships, both with themselves and with others. The Temple Index of Functional Fluency (TIFF<sup>®</sup>) is a validated behavioural tool, based on the Functional Fluency model, and provides insight into how a person distributes his or her energy across nine modes of behaviour and how effectively he or she does so. The leading question is: "Do I and others benefit and am I achieving my goals?"

In the TIFF<sup>®</sup> Provider Licensing Training you will learn to use Functional Fluency and TIFF<sup>®</sup> within your own profession. TIFF<sup>®</sup> is a unique instrument with which you can quickly and efficiently set up and substantiate a personal and or professional development programme together with your client. With TIFF<sup>®</sup> you have a powerful tool in your hands to support your clients in becoming more effective, energetic, productive, resilient and happy in their lives and in their work. TIFF<sup>®</sup> also offers you the possibility to increase your effectiveness as a helping professional and thus to add value.

#### Programme

The TIFF<sup>®</sup> Provider training is interactive and spans approximately 3 to 4 months in total. The training consists of four (or five\*) training days and two supervision sessions in groups. Prior to the training there is always a free and non-committal intake interview. If you decide to participate in the

training, you will undergo a so-called TIFF<sup>®</sup>-feedback session to explore your own TIFF<sup>®</sup>-profile.

\* Those without any prior knowledge of Transactional Analysis on which the Functional Fluency model is based will need to participate in day one of the training for an additional cost. This module is also provided as a separate course: TA inspiration for Functional Fluency

**On day 1** the focus is on (co-creative) Transactional Analysis (TA). This day helps participants to meet Functional Fluency from the perspective of an important development within TA in the past decade. Participation in this introductory day is also desirable and enriching for those who have already taken a TA course\*.

**On days 2 and 3,** participants will be trained in understanding and applying the Functional Fluency model and the TIFF<sup>®</sup> behavioural tool. In between, participants practice in pairs with three of their own practice clients, learning to apply the TIFF<sup>®</sup> tool in conversations.

**On days 4 and 5** further deepening takes place. Participants exchange experiences on applying the TIFF© instrument with their practice clients. Participants also gain insight into the connection with TA theory and the psychodynamic term 'transference'. Special attention is given to ethics. Participants learn how to work with the TIFF online system and receive information about membership to the Functional Fluency network, marketing and ongoing support.

**Supervision and self-study in between**. In the meantime, participants also receive supervision. In groups of a maximum of 4 participants they prepare for working with TIFF<sup>®</sup> with their practice clients, with support and supervision to ensure optimum learning and mentoring to continue learning, also from their own profile. Participants also talk extensively about their experiences with the TIFF<sup>©</sup> instrument in their own professional context. Finally, participants engage in self-study on the basis of information they receive during the training.

### Result

At the end of this training:

- You will have got to know Functional Fluency in its practical applicability as a unique body of thought and you will be able to explain the model interactively in coaching and training situations.
- You are skilled in the correct interpretation of the TIFF<sup>®</sup> profile of a client in relation to his/her coaching question.
- You will be able to discuss the TIFF<sup>®</sup> profile with a client in a supportive and empowering way.
- You can identify coaching themes and/or training needs that will further increase the (inter)personal effectiveness of the client when tackling the development issue.
- You will have got to know the support systems and the network that are accessible to you as a certified TIFF<sup>®</sup> Provider.

The TIFF<sup>®</sup> Provider Licensing Training is meant for professionals who guide other people in their personal and professional development.
